SENIOR CENTER TO OPEN AUGUST 3

Exciting news—the Monticello Senior Center Board of Directors made the decision to reopen the center on Monday, August 3! We have been busy planning for the reopening of our center with guidance from the city of Monticello, governor Walz, the CDC, and the MN Dept. of Health.

We can't wait to see you back!

We won't be able to go right back to "business as usual" and ask for you to be patient and understanding as we all adjust to the necessary changes.

Changes You Will See at Our Center...

- ⇒Governor Walz's Stay Safe MN order currently allows for groups of up to 10 people in the senior center at one time.
- ⇒Enter thru the main senior center door and exit thru Door #7 (by the ceramics room).
- ⇒Participants need to wear a mask. If you have one please bring it with you. If you do not have a mask we will provide one for you to keep.
- ⇒Wellness checks will be given at the door (temperature & simple questions asked).
- ⇒We ask that each participant sign a waiver document (only necessary once).
- ⇒A plexiglass buffer has been installed at the receptionist counter.
- ⇒Participants should stay at least 6' apart and should wash their hands frequently.
- ⇒Hand sanitizers are located throughout the center. Please use them often.
- ⇒Advance registration will be required for all activities until further notice.
- ⇒Drop-in participation will not be available while group numbers are limited.
- ⇒No food or beverages will be served or shared in the senior center.
- ⇒We will temporarily stop accepting donations of all items except excess produce (and money, of course)

Please read this newsletter carefully to become aware of when allowable activities are scheduled.
