Treasure Island Casino Trip

You can ride the coach bus to Treasure Island Casino on Monday, August 1. The bus will depart the community center at 8:30 a.m. and return at about 3:45 p.m. There is an \$20 bus ride charge and those going will receive \$15 on their card and a \$3 off food coupon. Please sign up and pay at least 1 week prior to the trip date.

Riverboat Cruise

This August 24 two-hour Picnic Lunch Cruise on the Mississippi River may be full. You can add your name to the waiting list if you wish. The cost is \$70 per person and includes transportation, riverboat cruise, lunch, and escort.

Osceola Train Ride

Return to 1948 on the vintage St Croix Valley Railway in Osceola, Wisconsin on Thursday, September 29. You will be served a boxed lunch onboard which includes a turkey sandwich with lettuce and tomato, chips, cookie, and beverage.

The train ride will bring you through the bluffs and you will have beautiful views of the woodlands. You will cross the St. Croix River on a swing bridge that used to open to allow Steamboats to pass through. After the train ride the coach bus will bring you to Sprouting Out in Center City where you can shop for award winning cheese, bison products, and specialty gifts.

The cost is \$83 per person. The coach bus will depart the community center at 9 a.m. and return at about 3:30 p.m.

The bus will depart the community center at 9:15 a.m. and return at about 4:45 p.m. The cost is \$68 per person and the deadline to register is September 12.

Driver Classes

People age 55+ completing a defensive driving class are eligible to receive a 10% auto insurance discount. The cost is \$25.

Four-hour refresher courses for those who have previously completed an eight-hour course will be held on August 10, September 8, October 6, November 16, and December 7 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.
