

Ride the coach bus to Mystic Lake Casino on Monday, February 7. The bus departs the community center at 8:30 a.m. and returns at about 3:15 p.m. There is an \$18 charge and those going will receive \$15 on their casino card and a \$4 off food coupon.

#### Science Museum/Omni Theater

Enjoy a fun day in St Paul with seniors from Elk River on February 24. The coach bus will bring you to Degidios Italian Restaurant where you will be served Parmesan Crusted Chicken Breast served over spaghetti with classic tomato sauce and baked mozzarella. Garlic bread and a beverage is also included with your meal.

After lunch you will arrive at the Science Museum where you can visit the exhibits at your own pace. Choose from permanent exhibits such as Collector's Corner, Dinosaurs and Fossils Gallery, Human Body Gallery, Mississippi River Gallery, and much more!

Next you will see a show in the Omni Theater. Show titles have not yet been announced but will be announced on their website a few weeks prior to the trip date. Please note that there will be a significant amount of walking on this trip.

# Church Basement Ladies 20th Anniversary Tour

This March 1 trip to the Paramount Center for the Arts in St. Cloud may be full. You can add your name to the waiting list if you wish. The bus will depart the community center at 11 a.m. and return at 4:15 p.m. The cost is \$68. Proof of COVID vaccine or negative test is required.

#### **Treasure Island Casino**

Ride the coach bus to Treasure Island Casino on Monday, March 7. The bus departs the community center at 8:30 a.m. and returns at about 3:45 p.m. There is an \$18 charge for the bus ride and those going will receive \$15 on their casino card and a \$3 off food coupon.

#### St. Paul Sinners and Saints

Arrive at the Landmark Center in St. Paul On April 6 and imagine that you're living in St. Paul's tumultuous era of prohibition and gangsters. The Gangster Tours are enhanced by humorous and lively costumed guides who adopt the personae of the infamous gangsters who resided in St. Paul during the 1930s, telling of their "lives as gangsters" and how the criminal justice system functioned during that era.

Then enjoy lunch at Kéy's Café where the menu includes luncheon portion turkey dinner with all the trimmings, beverage, and dessert.

Next there will be a guided tour of the St. Paul Cathedral. It is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest completed church in the United States, and the 4<sup>th</sup> tallest. The interior is illuminated by 24 stained glass windows featuring angelic choirs. The building was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1974. After the tour, visit the space at your own pace, and stop by gift Kiosks to purchase a memento of your visit.

The cost is \$84 per person. The bus will depart the community center at 8:30 a.m. and return at about 4 p.m. Deadline to register is March 6.

### **Caregiver Support Group**

If you are caring for someone either close or from afar, be sure to check out the Caregiver Support Group that meets at the center on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of each month (February 10) from 10:30 a.m. to noon.

This group is facilitated by Licensed Social Worker Becky Allard, provides specialized support and education, and is intended for nonprofessional caregivers. Call the center at 763-295-2000 if you plan to attend.

### **HOME Program**

The senior center's HOME Program can assist older adults with maintenance and cleaning both indoors and out. Help is available on a sliding fee scale with housekeeping, minor repair services, painting, snow removal, etc. All staff take precautions to ensure safety.
