Free Tax Assistance

Low to moderate-income people of all ages can get their taxes prepared at the center free of charge on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from February 1 thru April 11. Appointments are required.

Be sure to bring with you to your appointment a copy of your last return, picture ID, Social Security card, W2's, 1099's, SSA-1099 forms, other income and/or tax documents for 2023, and rent receipts (CRP) for 2023 or property tax statements for 2023 and 2024.

Be sure to organize your information before your appointment.



Treasure Island Casino

We will be sharing a coach bus to Treasure Island Casino on Monday, February 5 with participants from the Crow River Senior Center.

The bus will depart the Monticello Community Center at 8 a.m. and return at approximately 4:15 p.m. There is a \$20 charge and those going will receive \$15 on their casino card to spend and \$5 off food.

The Jason Show

Arrive at Fox 9 KMSP Broadcast Center in Eden Prairie on Tuesday, February 27 and be a part of the LIVE Studio Audience of The Jason Show. After the show, Jason is usually available for a group photo or to answer questions, but this is not always guaranteed. After the show have lunch at the Scoreboard in Minnetonka where you will be served the Special of the Day with a beverage. The last stop will be to The Pavek Broadcast Museum for a self-guided tour.

Please note: There are limited restrooms available to the public at the Jason Show. A valid ID is needed at check in to the Jason Show and everyone must go through a Security Screening. Consider wearing solid bright colors as those photograph the best. The studio is usually kept cooler so dress accordingly. The cost is \$85. The bus will depart the community center at 7:30 a.m. and return at about 4:15 p.m.

Treasure Island Casino

We will be sharing a coach bus to Treasure Island Casino on Monday, March 4 with participants from the Rogers Senior Center.

The bus will depart the Monticello Community Center at 8 a.m. and return at approximately 4:15 p.m. There is a \$20 charge and those going will receive \$15 on their casino card to spend and \$5 off food.

Share a bus on Tuesday, March 12 with seniors from Elk River and head to the Paramount Theater in St. Cloud to see Sinatra – "My Way" with Andrew Walesch and His Orchestra. Frank Sinatra has one of the most recognizable voices of all time. Join Andrew Walesch and his Big Band as they take you through Sinatra's legendary recording career.

Prior to the show, enjoy a buffet lunch at Molitor's Quarry Grill & Bar featuring chicken, mashed potatoes, gravy, dressing, coleslaw, green beans, dinner rolls, and beverages. The cost is \$83 per person. The coach bus will depart the community center at 10:30 a.m. and return at approximately 4:15 p.m.

State Capitol & History Center

Enjoy a 45-minute guided tour of the MN State Capitol on Wednesday, April 10. You will receive an overview of Capitol history, art, architecture, and state government. After the tour you will have lunch at Degidio's Restaurant and be served chicken parmesan over spaghetti, garlic bread, and a beverage.

The final stop will be to the History Center in St. Paul to spend time exploring on your own "The Life and Art of Charles M Schulz" exhibit. There will also be time for you to shop at the museum store. The cost is \$82 per person. The bus will depart the community center at 8 a.m. and return at about 4:15 p.m.

Driver Classes

People age 55+ completing a defensive driving class are eligible to receive a 10% auto insurance discount. The cost is \$25.

Four-hour refresher courses for those who have previously completed an eight-hour class will be held on February 22, March 20, and April 24 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Call for more dates.

Drop off or mail payment (cash or check) to the center in advance. Checks are payable to the Monticello Senior Center. Class size is limited and people must register in advance. Please note that refunds will not be given for no-shows.
