Historian David Jones will give this presentation at the center at 10 a.m. on Friday, January 19 in the Mississippi Room. There is no charge to attend and people are asked to sign up in advance.

# Tax Assistance Begins in February

Low to moderate-income people of all ages can get their taxes prepared at the center free of charge on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from February 1 thru April 11. Appointments are required and can be made starting January 2.

Be sure to bring with you to your appointment a copy of your last return, picture ID, Social Security card, W2's, 1099's, SSA-1099 forms and other income and/or tax documents for 2023 and rent receipts (CRP) for 2023 or property tax statements for 2023 and 2024.

Be sure to organize your information before your appointment.



#### Please Join Us for Dinner

Four area restaurants provide tasty noon meals at the senior center Tuesday-Friday. Chin Yuen provides meals on Tuesdays, American Legion Post 260 on Wednesdays, VFW Post 8731 on Thursdays, and Cornerstone Café on Fridays.

The meal cost is \$5 and people age 55+ and spouse regardless of age are welcome to participate. People do have to sign up at least 1 business day in advance by noon and pay for meals they order.

The senior center will be closed on Mondays, January 1 and 15

Senior center card tournaments are open to people age 55+. All games have a \$2 entry fee and prize money is paid to the tournament winners.

#### **Overnight Casino Trip**

You can ride the coach bus to Jackpot Junction Casino on Wednesday, January 17. The bus will depart the Monticello Community Center at 8 a.m. on January 17 and return at approximately 3:45 p.m. on January 18.

The cost is \$99 per person double occupancy and \$121 single. In addition to your hotel room, you will receive \$50 in slot play and two \$5 off food coupons.

#### **Winter Dance Party**
