Low to moderate-income people of all ages can get their taxes prepared at the center free of charge on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from February 2 thru April 13. Appointments are required.

Be sure to bring with you to your appointment a copy of your last return, picture ID, Social Security card, W2's, 1099's, SSA-1099 forms and other income and/or tax documents for 2022 and rent receipts (CRP) for 2022 or property tax statements for 2022 and 2023.

Be sure to organize your information before your appointment.

Wright County Public Health nurses will be at our center on February 7 & 28 to assist people age 60+ with toenail clipping. Two appointment dates are available because of the high demand for this service in our area.
