Free tax assistance for low to moderateincome persons will be available on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Call the senior center to schedule an appointment and it is imperative that you bring all pertinent tax information with you and fill out an Intake Form in advance (pick up at the senior center).

Your tax documents will be scanned during your appointment and returned to you. You will receive a phone call to come and pick up your tax return when completed and sign giving permission to efile.
