Low to moderate-income people of all ages can get their taxes prepared at the center free of charge on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays thru April 13. Appointments are required.

Be sure to bring with you to your appointment a copy of your last return, picture ID, Social Security card, W2's, 1099's, SSA-1099 forms and other income and/or tax documents for 2022 and rent receipts (CRP) for 2022 or property tax statements for 2022 and 2023.

Be sure to organize your information before your appointment.

Incident at Our Lady of Perpetual Help

Take a trip back to 1973 with the Irish Catholic O'Shea family in the uproarious, "Incident at Our Lady of Perpetual Help." This boisterous and moving new memory play introduces us to young Linda, as she recalls a week she'll never forget. Linda's mother instructs her to tell her sister about the birds and the bees and things quickly snowball into a potential crisis after the conversation is overheard by the parish priest. Secrets are unintentionally revealed and the women work to protect their family reputations and each other.

You can take in this wild and tender comedy at the Sidekick Theater on Thursday, April 20. The bus will depart the community center at 9:45 a.m. and returns at about 4:30 p.m. The trip fee of \$75 includes coach transportation, show, lunch, and escort. Deadline—March 17.

Enjoy lunch prior to the show featuring creamy chicken breast, roasted red potatoes, glazed carrots, coleslaw, dinner rolls, assorted dessert, coffee, and hot tea.

Wabasha Street Caves

Explore the Wabasha Street Caves in St. Paul with a very knowledgeable tour guide on Wednesday, May 10. The Wabasha Street Caves are the only remaining restored Gangster Era site. The caves are carved into the hillside in a long abandoned mining venture from the 1800's. Later the caves were a mushroom farm, and then developed as a Restaurant Casino and gangster hotspot during the 1930's prohibition era.

Prior to the tour, you will have lunch onsite. The menu will be The Italian Mobster Buffet: Caesar salad, beef lasagna, penne pasta bake with chicken alfredo, fresh green beans, garlic bread sticks, and assorted cookies, bars and coffee.

The cost is \$75 per person and the deadline to register is April 10. The coach bus will depart the community center at 11:15 a.m. and return at about 3:45 p.m.

Driver Classes

People age 55+ completing a defensive driving class are eligible to receive a 10% auto insurance discount. The cost is \$25.

Four-hour refresher courses for those who have previously completed an eight-hour course will be held on March 8, April 19, and May 10 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. You can call for more dates.
