You can enjoy a tour of the Le Duc Mansion in Hastings on Thursday, December 7. The mansion is decked out in Victoria style for the holiday season. This 15-room house stands as a rare monument of unaltered Gothic Revival architecture. The tour includes both the first and second floor and there is not an elevator. Those who want to go outside can visit the Carriage Barn and Simmons Shed which have additional exhibits on display.

Lunch will be in the parlor and includes chicken salad on a croissant, fruit salad, vegetable, dessert, water, tea, or coffee. Following lunch, you will go to the Alexis Bailly Vineyard to taste and purchase wine.
