AED Class

Sudden Cardiac Arrest is a national public health crisis that affects 1,000 people a day and strikes all ages. Only 1 in 10 victims of SCA survive. Through training sessions and community awareness events, Heart Strong Monticello is dedicated to increasing the number of bystanders who will administer hands-only CPR and use an available AED in the critical minutes prior to the arrival of Emergency Medical Services.

In a one-hour, hands-on training at the center on Friday, October 25 at 10 a.m., we will help participants learn the skills necessary to help increase the survival rate in our community from 1 in 10, to 5 in 10. Please sign up if you plan to attend.
