Just a few months ago, we welcomed Lynne Fredrickson as the new Director of the Waconia Area Senior Center. In the short time she's been in her role, she has introduced a variety of new activities and programs, developed valuable processes for day-to-day operations, and significantly increased interest in the center across the community.
