

#### LEGAL AID APPOINTMENTS

The St. Cloud office of Mid-Minnesota Legal Aid has received a grant of Older American Act funds from the Central Minnesota Council on Aging to provide legal services for seniors residing in Wright County. The funds will be used to provide legal advice, counseling and representation in court and administrative hearings. There is no cost for these services. If you are 60 years or older and reside in Wright County, you can get help with legal problems involving Medicare, Social Security, eviction or other housing problems, public benefits, such as medical assistance, food support and fuel assistance, family law issues, including domestic abuse and income maintenance, nursing home problems, home care services, powers of attorney, health care directives and debt collection. No help is provided for criminal matters, wills, estate planning or real estate transactions. Seniors can also call the St. Cloud office of Mid-Minnesota Legal Aid free at 1-888-360-2889 for scheduling an appointment. Online access: http://mylegalaid.org. Minnesota Legal Aid accepts contributions for legal services, but contributions are not required to receive legal help. Legal appointments are held monthly at the Center.







Thanksgiving was celebrated at our house with our aunts, uncles and cousins in attendance. It was the usual fun with the big dinner-kids sitting at a kids table in the living room. We liked sitting away from the adults as this gave us a chance to relax our table manners. The menu was the typical Scandinavian spread. Turkey, potato sausage, mashed potatoes, dressing, corn and gravy plus the relishes, cranberries and pickles. They always made sure there were ripe olives which made us happy as it was a game to place an olive on each finger on one hand and dance our fingers around as puppets. The potato sausage was another big hit as each ring of potato sausage had a tail on each end. The boys enjoyed grossing the girls out by squeezing the sausage so it squirted out of the tail. The parents never said anything as they knew we were just having some fun. Time getting close for the guests to leave, it was time for the cousins to write our name on a piece of paper and list the things we would like for Christmas. It came out OK as the four Olson kids equaled the other two families.

About a week later our mother got into high gear and started preparing for the Christmas celebrations. There were all the cookies to bake and other treats to make. Shopping for the gifts for everyone. I remember Mom and my aunt Yvonne would take a whole day and go somewhere where there were a larger selection of stores and do a power shopping. Yvonne did not yet know how to drive and her and Mom always came home tired but laughing. I guess they made the shopping day a special day of having fun. In later years we would hear some of the things that would make their day special.

Mom had to work hard to wrap all the gifts for us kids when we were in school. It was the Christmas when I was about 8 years old, Pat was 12, Richard was 11 and Jeannie 7 months. Pat and I had asked for figure skates. We weren't sure if we would get them but we were hoping. One Saturday afternoon after we had finished our share of the cleaning, we started to browse thru the wrapped gifts that were pilled on the couch in the big hallway upstairs. Sure enough, we found a gift for each of us. Should we or should we not? That was the big question and temptation. We talked about it and giggled about it until we convinced ourselves that we could open the paper carefully and retape it. Mom would never know. Just don't let Richard know or he would tell on us. We did it! Yes, there were our hoped-for ice skates. After we had fixed the wrapping and set the boxes back where they had been we looked at each other and the excitement in our eyes turned to sadness as we realized that now we would not be surprised on Christmas eve and would we be able to pull off being really surprised when we open our gifts? I never did that again as I realized that half the fun is the anticipation.
